Wellness Update – April Bryan

- April Bryan stated a balance ball class was conducted last month at the Robert L. Taylor Community Center.
- More wellness classes will be held during lunch time.
- The Finance Department won the walking challenge again.
- Retirees can now obtain a 90 day mail order supply of medication at the health center. They will receive 90 day supply at scheduled doctor appointment and a script to mail to the health center's prescription vendor for another 90 day supply. Mailing will go out to retirees eligible for health center use on this prescription option.
 - Last year 117 retirees used the health center compared to 184 this year.

Other Business

- Stacie Mason said we will be focusing on OPEB's funding liability of a \$10.3 million for next fiscal year.
 - Recommendations will be made to the City Commission. Changes could possibly impact the whole plan design. A City Commission OPEB workshop will be scheduled end of June or beginning of July to discuss and approve any changes. The Agenda will provide the backup material.
 - The Gehring Group has been retained to consult with our actuarial and the city on this issue.
 - The high deductible plan has been successful. Many younger retirees are enrolling in this plan.
 - Stacie suggested we publish information to communicate on the possible changes to fund OPEB.
- Currently, Dr. Roberts staffs the health center. A male doctor soon may be hired that can offer to options for participants on who to schedule their appointments with.
- A Group member stated that Gail Nowacky was very helpful with a claim that she rectified in a week.
