

# Sarasota Memorial Internal Medicine – Newtown

## *A Residency Practice Providing Comprehensive Team-Based Care*

Sarasota Memorial Internal Medicine – Newtown is a group physician practice that offers comprehensive, coordinated care and accessible services to patients over the age of 18.

The practice will be staffed by resident physicians training under the direct supervision of experienced and board-certified Internal Medicine physicians on the faculty of Florida State University College of Medicine's Internal Medicine Residency Program at Sarasota Memorial. Residents are doctors who completed medical school and are continuing training in their chosen specialty, in this case Internal Medicine.

We encourage and offer primary and preventive care, including:

- ▶ Physicals, annual exams and adult vaccinations
- ▶ Care for chronic conditions, such as diabetes, high blood pressure, lupus, thyroid disease and pulmonary disease
- ▶ Care for acute illness, such as the flu, pneumonia, ear and fungal infections
- ▶ Counseling regarding your health and lifestyle concerns, including pharmacy and nutrition consults

### Patient-Centered, Team-Based Approach

Our residents will work closely with attending faculty physicians throughout their three years of training. As a patient of Sarasota Memorial Internal Medicine – Newtown, that means more than one physician will be guiding and advising you on your health care. Residents generally have more time to spend with patients, while supervising physicians review all care provided.

### Service Hours & Appointments

The practice will open July 1, 2017, with 13 resident physicians and their supervising Sarasota Memorial physicians. Patients also will have access to a multi-disciplinary team of providers, including registered dietitians, pharmacy residents and social workers who will work together to ensure you receive the care you need to maximize your overall health and well being.

Services will be provided from 9 am to 5 pm weekdays by appointment. The office is not a walk-in clinic and does not offer urgent or emergency medical care. Limited same-day appointments will be available.

### Insurance & Financial Assistance

The Internal Medicine Practice will accept most commercial insurances, including Medicare and Medicaid. Sarasota Memorial is proud to serve our community with affordable health care by providing free and discounted care to uninsured patients in need of assistance.
