When: Wednesday, April 20th

Explanation: The City of Sarasota is in the process of rewriting the City's Zoning Code and creating a Form-based Code (FBC). A FBC addresses both the private and public space of the City to create a walkable, urban fabric consistent with the community vision.

In an effort to ensure that new construction and infrastructure projects are in harmony and produce quality spaces, the City is creating subarea plan exhibits that will be incorporated into the code. These are referred to as The Regulating Plan and Special Requirement Plans. They are used to create the metrics and specific regulations needed to produce the desired urban form. These plans are also designed to work in conjunction with the City's Multimodal Transportation Plan.

Additionally, the County has several plan updates in progress including its SCAT Comprehensive Operations Analysis. Working together, the two staffs will be holding these events to maximize participation and allow citizens to examine the plans in a holistic manner in order to provide feedback.
